Dear Bertrand,

Several people have requested to know exactly how to proceed to obtain a Nutritional Blood Chemistry Analysis. Below we have outlined a few different options for you.

How to Obtain a Nutritional Blood Chemistry Analysis

To arrange to have blood work done

To arrange to have blood tests and an analysis you call us with your birthdate, address, telephone number, credit card information and e-mail address. We will order the test through Directlabs on the internet. They will send a requisition form to a lab near you and send you a copy. At that time they will ask you to authorize the results being sent to me. You will then go to the lab near you that they recommend. The lab will draw the blood and conduct the tests and the results are sent to DirectLabs. They in turn will send the lab report to me. My office will enter the data into my computer and get the analysis and then we arrange for an appointment. At that time I'll ask you to fill a comprehensive metabolic questionnaire. During our session we will review all that information plus the information generated through my intuitive analysis and then together decide upon a constructive course of action. Two to three months later we redo the tests to verify whether the treatment is producing the desired outcome.

How does it work if have the test done by my MD?

We can process any standard blood test through our software. The more comprehensive the test, the more valuable data we will generate. The tests we use include the following elements:

Complete Blood Count (CBC)
Thyroid Profile w/TSH
Lipid Profile
Liver Profile

Kidney Panel
Minerals and Bone
Fluids and Electrolytes
Diabetes

When the blood tests are done arrange to have them faxed to our office. Our fax number is 303 823 5378.

If you want more details about these tests, please let us know and we will give you specific information about each area mentioned above. In addition, many additional tests can be analyzed through this software to determine natural treatment strategies. These would include among others more comprehensive cardiovascular panels and more thorough glandular panels including thyroid, adrenals, and male and female hormones.
